

The articles derived from research submitted to *Senderos Pedagógicos Journal* must meet the following publication criteria. This information can also be found at goo.gl/Mq6nKt

- The articles must be unpublished, without prior publication in other editorial media or academic dissemination, and without parallel postulation for publication in another journal.
- In order to ensure confidentiality and transparency in the editorial process, research articles should not contain the name or other information that reveals the author's identity. Personal information is included in the author's index card, which is available at goo.gl/Mq6nKt
- Up to three (3) authors per article are allowed.
- Texts should be between 4,000 and 7,000 words, including footnotes, references, tables, figures and maps.
- Manuscripts must be written in the third person.
- We ask the author to avoid excessive self-quotation and any type of information in the body of the text that offers clues about his identity or that of the authors' group.
- The title should not exceed 10 words; 15 including the subtitle.
- The summary must not exceed 150 words. It must be written in a single paragraph and should not contain references or abbreviations.
- Key words: include three (3) to five (5) keywords taken from the Unesco thesaurus: <http://databases.unesco.org/thessp>
- The title, abstract and keywords must be translated into English.
- The structure to be followed by an article as a result of a research is: introduction, methodology, results and discussion, conclusions and references. See support guide at goo.gl/Mq6nKt
- Articles submitted for consideration must be written in Word for Windows format, Times New Roman, 12 points, letter size, previous and posterior spacing zero (0) points, 1.5 spacing and written to a single column.
- Quotes and references must follow the APA rules (6th Edition). They can be consulted in detail at goo.gl/Mq6nKt
- If the article includes tables or figures, sufficiently clear originals should be attached to ease the editing.
- Texts must not exceed five (5) tables and figures in total.

- When using an acronym or abbreviation, the full equivalence is first registered and then, in brackets, the term that will be used in the rest of the text.
- If a word is highlighted in the text and some Anglicism is used, it is recommended that it be in italics. However, in the first case, this should not be abused.
- The numbers inside the text are prose, followed by the Arabic number in parentheses. Example: three (3) people were interviewed.
- Footers are used to make comments or clarifications that enrich the text; they should be short and in no case should be used to quote authors. They must be transcribed in Times New Roman, 10 points.
- References go at the end of article, in alphabetical order, and only the ones cited in the article must be listed. They must be written in 11-point Times New Roman, and have single line spacing.

Submitting the Articles

The articles should be sent to the electronic mail senderos@tdea.edu.co, using the subject to point out the section to which it belongs. When postulating the article, the author's index card must be attached in a separate file.
